2.0 FINANCIAL **2.07 PROCUREMENT OF SERVICES**

Purpose

To outline the policy and procedures for procuring services for the Saskatchewan Information and Privacy Commissioner (IPC).

Policy

The IPC is responsible for ensuring services are awarded through a fair, open and transparent manner.

The IPC must ensure communications policies with respect to print, communications and promotional purchases and those requirements for personal service contracts are followed. Contracting for private legal services must be done in consultation with the Commissioner.
