Saskatchewan Information and Privacy Commissioner Tables *2015-2016 Annual Report*

Saskatchewan Information and Privacy Commissioner, Ronald J. Kruzeniski, Q.C. has submitted his office's *2015-2016 Annual Report* to the Legislative Assembly. Kruzeniski stated:

“This is my second Annual Report filed as the Information and Privacy Commissioner and I hope it reflects the path I have taken over the last two years and intend to pursue over the next three years.”

And he further stated:

“It is still necessary to update the existing legislation and in that process necessary to strike a balance between access to personal health information and protection of personal health information.

In continuing the work to update legislation and strike the balance, I have proposed amendments to *The Health Information Protection Act (HIPA)*, a summary of which are contained in the Annual Report. I hope to work with the Ministry of Health, the Ministry of Justice and stakeholders in the health sector to bring these proposals to the Legislative Assembly.

I am most pleased that Bills 30 and 31 have been tabled in the Legislative Assembly which contains amendments to *The Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* and *The Local Authority Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*. *These Bills further the efforts to update access and privacy legislation in Saskatchewan.*”
