The International conference of Data Protection and Privacy Commissioners is an annual conference attended by 78 nations. Data protection authorities and privacy commissioners from these nations are involved with this conference and participated in a two day closed session. This resulted in a number of resolutions that are described in our September – October e-newsletter "The Saskatchewan FOIP FOLIO." The international conference is an invaluable opportunity to learn about experience with electronic health record developments not available in Canada and a potential new international privacy instrument that may eclipse the current *Model Code for the Protection of Personal Information*.
