

ADDENDUM TO REPORT WITH RESPECT TO
REVIEW OF REQUEST FOR INFORMATION
BY [REDACTED] TO EXECUTIVE COUNCIL

Since issuing my report with respect to this matter, it has come to my attention that the Copyright Act of Canada contain the following specific provision:

"27(2)(i) The following acts do not constitute an infringement of copyright:

- (i) the disclosure pursuant to The Access to Information Act of a record within the meaning of that Act, or the disclosure, pursuant to any like Act of the legislature of a province, of like material."

Accordingly, the claim by [REDACTED] as a third party that disclosure of the material in question would infringe its rights with respect to copyright appear to be ill-founded.
