ADDENDUM TO REPORT WITH RESPECT TO REVIEW OF REQUEST FOR INFORMATION BY TO EXECUTIVE COUNCIL

Since issuing my report with respect to this matter, it has come to my attention that the Copyright Act of Canada contain the following specific provision:

"27(2)(i) The following acts do not constitute an infringement of copyright:

(i) the disclosure pursuant to The Access to Information Act of a record within the meaning of that Act, or the disclosure, pursuant to any like Act of the legislature of a province, of like material."

Accordingly, the claim by as a third party that disclosure of the material in question would infringe its rights with respect to copyright appear to be ill-founded.
