
Simplified Steps for Access to Information in Saskatchewan

What is a Public Body?

Government Institutions include Executive Council, crown corporations, ministries, boards, commissions, or any department, secretariat or agency of the executive government of Saskatchewan. <u>The Freedom of</u> <u>Information and Protection of Privacy</u> <u>Act</u> (FOIP) applies.

Local Authorities include municipal governments (city, rural municipality, etc.), regional health authorities, school boards, library boards, colleges or universities. <u>The Local Authority</u> <u>Freedom of Information and Protection</u> of Privacy Act (LA FOIP) applies.

Health **Trustees** include government institutions, regional health authorities, doctors, dentists, pharmacies, personal care homes, etc. <u>The Health</u> <u>Information Protection Act</u> (HIPA) applies.



Reviewable Issues

- Refused access to all or part of the record
- The record does not exist / cannot be found
- The existence of the record shall neither be confirmed nor denied
- No reply to an application submitted over 30 days ago
- Correction to a personal information record was not accepted as correct/verifiable
- Review of a decision to give access to a record that affects third party interests
- Dissatisfied with fee estimate
- Request for a fee waiver was refused
- Dissatisfied with the transfer of application
- Dissatisfied with the manner of providing access
- Dissatisfied with the need to extend the 30-day response period.
